Porter Relay Trophy (End of Summer Season Championships)



Presented by Mr. A.A. Porter in 1970- 1971 season

- (a) Swimmers are to be fully financial competitive members.
- (b) To be present on the night of the swim.
- (c) To be swum as a team consisting of four $(4) \times 50 \text{ m}$ legs.
- (d) Relay team listing to be compiled by the Club Handicapper.
- (e) Uneven number of swimmers to be left to the Handicapper's Decision (ie, some swimmers may be required to swim 2 legs).
- (f) Relay to be swum as a handicap race. Heats first followed by finals where necessary.
- (g) Swimmers are required to have swum a 50m Freestyle in the current season qualify.
- (h) Trophies are to be awarded under the following guidelines1st Place, if there are only 1-4 competing teams.1st and 2nd Place, if there is between 5-8 competing teams.
 - 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place, if there are 9 or more competing teams.

100m (4x25m) Individual Medley Champion (End of Summer Season Championship)



Trophy first awarded in the 1973-74 Season by Dolphins-Sth Aust-Trophy. Was awarded until 1989-1990 and then reintroduced in 2003-2004

Trophy was from 1993-94 season for 8 seasons 200m with trophy donated by Summit Realty Kwinana

- (a) Swimmers are to be fully financial competitive members.
- (b) To any swimmer 10 years and under on the day of the championship who wishes to compete.
- (c) Swimmers are required to record 2 separate times on Club Nights prior to the Championships to be eligible.
- (d) Championship to be swum as a Timed Final.
- (e) Swimmers are required to have competed in at least 4 summer club race meets as per the scale under General Conditions.
- (f) Swimmers are required to have fulfilled the Team Selection criteria as per the scale under General Conditions.
- (g) Trophies will be awarded to a Male and a Female Winner and Runner Up.

200m (4x50m) Individual Medley Intermediate Champion (End of Summer Season Championship)



Trophy first awarded in the 1977-78 season until by Social Club.
Then Cable Jointing Statewide from 1997-98 Season onwards.

- (a) Swimmers are to be fully financial competitive members.
- (b) Swimmers must be between the ages of 11 years and 13 years on the day of the championship.
- (c) Championship to be swum as a Timed Final.
- (d) Swimmers are required to have competed in at least 4 summer club race meets as per the scale under General Conditions.
- (e) Swimmers are required to record 2 separate times on Club Nights to be eligible.
- (f) Swimmers are required to have fulfilled the Team Selection criteria as per the scale under General Conditions.
- (g) Trophies will be awarded to a Male and a Female Winner and Runner Up.

200m (4x50m) Individual Medley 14yrs/Ov Champion (End of Summer Season Championship)



Trophy first awarded in the 1973-74 season until by Vice President.

- (a) Swimmers are to be fully financial competitive members.
- (b) Swimmers must be 14 years and over on the day of the championship.
- (c) Championship to be swum as a Timed Final.
- (d) Swimmers are required to have competed in at least 4 summer club race meets as per the scale under General Conditions.
- (e) Swimmers are required to record 2 separate times on Club Nights to be eligible.
- (f) Swimmers are required to have fulfilled the Team Selection criteria as per the scale under General Conditions.
- (g) Trophies will be awarded to a Male and a Female Winner and Runner Up.

800m Freestyle Distance Champion (End of Summer Season Championship)





Male Trophy first awarded in the 1973-74 Season by Stephen Pringle (Life Member) as a 400m, then in 1979-80 became 800m Distance

Female Trophy first awarded in the 1981-82 Season by Tony Ball (Life Member) as a 400m, then in 1990-91 became 800m Distance

- (a) Swimmers are to be fully financial competitive members.
- (b) Distance to be swum is 800 metres Freestyle for Male and Females to be swum in combined sexes.
- (c) Event to be swum in divisions.
- (d) Minimum age for contesting this event is 10yrs/over on the day.
- (e) Swimmers are required to have competed in at least 4 summer club race meets as per the scale under General Conditions.
- (f) A qualifying time of 90 seconds for 100 metres Freestyle or the completion of an 800m Freestyle during the current winter/summer season is a pre-requisite.
- (g) Swimmers are required to have fulfilled the Team Selection criteria as per the scale under General Conditions.
- (h) Trophies will be awarded separately to the fastest male and fastest females under the following guidelines.
 - (a) 1st Place, if there are between 1-4 competitors
 - (b) 1st and 2nd Place, if there are between 5-8 competitors
 - (c) 1st, 2nd and 3rd Place, if there are 9 or more competitor.

Age Group Champion (End of Summer Season Championships)







First presented 1972 – 1973 season

Conditions

- (a) Swimmers are to be fully financial competitive members.
- (b) Age to be set as the age on the day of the Championships.
- (c) Swimmers are required to record 2 separate times in each of the 4 strokes (Butterfly, Backstroke, Breaststroke and Freestyle) on Club Nights prior to the Championships to be eligible.
- d) The following distances will apply to the following ages;
 - a) 10 years and under

50 metres

(b) 11 years and over

100 metres

- (e) The only exception for qualifying times for strokes will be 8yrs and under in Butterfly.
- (f) Where a child's age is 10 and turns 11 during the season, strokes qualified in 50m events will count towards 100m events.
- (g) Points towards the Championship must be accumulated from all four (4) strokes to be swum on the Championship day.
- (h) Trophies will be awarded to a Male and Female Winner and Runner Up.
- (i) Championship to be swum as a Timed Final.
- (j) The following ages will apply to the Age Group Champion.
 - (a) 7yrs and under, 8yrs, 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs, 16yrs, 17yrs, 18yrs and over.
- (k) Swimmers are required to have competed in at least 4 summer club race meets as per the scale under General Conditions.
- (I) Swimmers are required to have fulfilled the Team Selection criteria as per the scale under General Conditions.

Junior Champion 10yrs & Under (End of Summer Season Championship)





Trophy first awarded in the 1978-79.

- (a) Swimmers are to be fully financial competitive members.
- (b) Swimmers must be 10 years and under on the day of the Championship.
- (c) Championship to be swum as a Timed Final.
- (d) Swimmers are required to have competed in at least 4 summer club race meets as per the scale under General Conditions.
- (e) Swimmers are required to record 2 separate times in each of the 4 strokes: 50m Butterfly, 50m Backstroke, 50m Breaststroke and 50m Freestyle on Club nights to be eligible to compete.
- (f) Points toward the Championships must be accumulated from all four (4) strokes to be swum on the Championship day.
- (g) Trophies will be awarded to a Male and Female Winner and Runner Up.
- (h) Swimmers are required to have fulfilled the Team Selection criteria as per the scale under General Conditions.

Intermediate Champion 11yrs- 13yrs (End of Summer Season Championship)

- (a) Swimmers are to be fully financial competitive members.
- (b) Swimmers must be aged 11 and 13 years on the day of the Championship.
- (c) Championship to be swum as a Timed Final.
- (d) Swimmers are required to have competed in at least 4 summer club race meets as per the scale under General Conditions.
- (e) Swimmers are required to record 2 separate times in each of the 4 strokes: 100m Butterfly, 100m Backstroke, 100m Breaststroke and 100m Freestyle on Club nights to be eligible to compete.
- (f) Points toward the Championships must be accumulated from all four (4) strokes to be swum on the Championship day.
- (g) Trophies will be awarded to a Male and Female Winner and Runner Up.
- (h) Swimmers are required to have fulfilled the Team Selection criteria as per the scale under General Conditions.

A.I.S. Open Champion (End of Summer Season Championship)

- (d) Swimmers are required to have competed in at least 4 summer club race meets as per the scale under General Conditions.
- (e) Swimmers are required to record 2 separate times in each of the following events: 100m Butterfly, 100m Backstroke, 100m Breaststroke and 100m Freestyle on Club nights to be eligible.
- (f) Points toward the Championships must be accumulated from all four (4) strokes to be swum on the Championship day.
- (g) Trophies will be awarded to a Male and Female Winner and Runner Up
- (h) Swimmers are required to have fulfilled the Team Selection criteria as per the scale under General Conditions.

- (a) Swimmers are to be fully financial competitive members.
- (b) Swimmers are required to have competed in at least 4 summer club race meets as per the scale under General Conditions.
- (c) Awarded by the Club Handicapper based on swimmers being 12 years and under and improvement shown on times accumulating over all four (4) 50m strokes, either from their first recorded time of the season or their carryover time from the season before.
- (d) Swimmers are required to have fulfilled the Team Selection criteria as per the scale under General Conditions.

Conditions WHIDDETT FAMILY MOST IMPROVED SENIOR

- (a) Swimmers are to be fully financial competitive members.
- (b) Swimmers are required to have competed in at least 4 summer club race meets as per the scale under General Conditions.
- (c) Awarded by the Club Handicappers based on swimmers being 13 years and over and improvement shown on times accumulating over all four (4) 100m strokes, either from their first recorded time of the season or their carryover time from the season before.
- (d) Swimmers are required to have fulfilled the Team Selection criteria as per the scale under General Conditions.

Winter Points Trophy (Presented at end of Summer Season Awards)

- (a) Swimmers are to be fully financial competitive members.

- (c) Swimmers are required to record 2 separate times in each of the 4 strokes that obtain standard points (Butterfly, Backstroke, Breaststroke and Freestyle) on Club nights to be eligible.

- f) Swimmers are required to have competed in at least 4 winter club race meets as per the scale under General Conditions.

The overall points winner over the current season Points nights that are conducted and complies with the above will be deemed the recipient Male and Female winners of the Winter Points Trophy.

Further placing trophies will be based on the following criteria;

Runner Up Male and Female winners will be based on 9 - 16 qualified overall competitors,

3rd Placing Male and Female winners will be based on 17 – 24 qualified overall competitors,

4th Placing Male and Female winners will be based on 25 – 32 qualified overall competitors,

5th Placing Male and Female winners will be based on 33 – 40 qualified overall competitors,

6th Placing Male and Female winners will be based on 41 – 48 qualified overall competitors,

7th Placing Male and Female winners will be based on 49 – 56 qualified overall competitors,

8th Placing Male and Female winners will be based on 57 and greater qualified overall competitors.

- g) Swimmers who nominate for points swims and fails to compete same without valid medical reason will forfeit all points for the night.
- h) Swimmers are required to have fulfilled the Team Selection criteria as per the scale under General Conditions.

The overall points winner over the current season Points nights that are conducted and complies with the above will be deemed the recipient Male and Female winners of the Winter Points Trophy.

Further placing trophies will be based on the following criteria;

Runner Up Male and Female winners will be based on 9 - 16 qualified overall competitors,

3rd Placing Male and Female winners will be based on 17 – 24 qualified overall competitors,

4th Placing Male and Female winners will be based on 25 – 32 qualified overall competitors,

5th Placing Male and Female winners will be based on 33 – 40 qualified overall competitors,

6th Placing Male and Female winners will be based on 41 – 48 qualified overall competitors,

7th Placing Male and Female winners will be based on 49 – 56 qualified overall competitors,

Conditions

- (a) Must be a fully financial member.
- (b) Be a Competitive member, whether it be with Swimming WA or Masters WA

Must have won GOLD at either the State Open, State Age or Junior Championships Long Course or Short Course.

Must have won a GOLD at State Open Water Championships.

Must have won GOLD at Royal Life Saving State Championships.

Must have medalled at Australian Open or Australian Age Championships. Must have medalled at Masters National Championships. Must have medalled at Australian Open Water Championships. Must have medalled at Australian Royal Life Saving State Championships.

Must have been a finalist at Australian Open Championships

Have broken a State Record during the course of the season.



10 Years Service Members Honour Board



Conditions

(a) Must be a full financial member.

Recognised to swimmers over a period of time who have achieved 10 years actual swimming membership. This membership does not have to be continuous and can be broken service.

Life Members Honour Board



Conditions

(a) Be a financial member.

Life Members shall be elected by the members at the Annual General Meeting with the minimum requirement being ten (10) years meritorious service to the Club.

Life Members of the Club shall not pay any fees to the club, however the club is responsible for paying the capitation fee towards Swimming WA if the said Life Member is still being actively involved in the club.

Trophy Awards General Conditions

Conditions

No swimmer is eligible for accumulation of points and swim met qualifying conditions until Club Membership and Registration fees are paid in full.

A swimmer disqualified for incorrect action is disqualified from that event only and is not debarred thereby from the overall championship.

In case of a Dead Heat in any championship, dual trophies shall be awarded.

Where eligibility is required to have swum in Points Meets and Team Selection Competitions during the season. This provision may be waived by the Club in special circumstances.

POINTS MEETING SCALE

Swimmers are required to compete in a minimum number of Club Race Meets during the relevant Summer or Calendar season to be eligible to compete in certain trophy events.

The scale works as follows

must attend 8 out of 14

must attend 7 out of 13

must attend 7 out of 12

must attend 6 out of 11

must attend 6 out of 10

must attend 5 out of 9

must attend 5 out of 8

must attend 4 out of 7

must attend 4 out of 6

TEAM SELECTION SCALE

Swimmers are required to compete in a minimum number of Team Selection Competitions that they have been selected for to be eligible in certain trophy events.

The scale works as follows

must attend 7 out of 10

must attend 6 out of 9

must attend 6 out of 8

must attend 5 out of 7

must attend 4 out of 6

must attend 3 out of 5

must attend 3 out of 4

must attend 2 out of 3

must attend 1 out of 2

must attend 0 out of 1

Trophy Awards General Conditions (continued)

Conditions continued

Swimmers wishing to have eligibility conditions for any Trophy Event waived is required to submit in **WRITING** with the relevant reason, addressed to the Honorary Secretary at least fourteen (14) days before the scheduled date of the applicable Trophy event. Such letter when received will be presented to the next Club Meeting for discussion. In the event there is not a club meeting due, an Executive Meeting will be held for the purpose of discussing the request.

Swimmers are expected to be available for selection at all times for Interclub Competitions with at least 10 days notice given to swimmers.

No exceptions will be accepted for other sporting commitments.

There is a penalty incurred for those swimmers who don't let the Handicappers know that they can't turn up to a Team Selection event. At the next attended Points Meet they receive no points but still retain status for attending swims and recorded strokes.

Swimmers refusing to swim events at Team Selection events will be penalised 5 points from the Age Group Championships.
